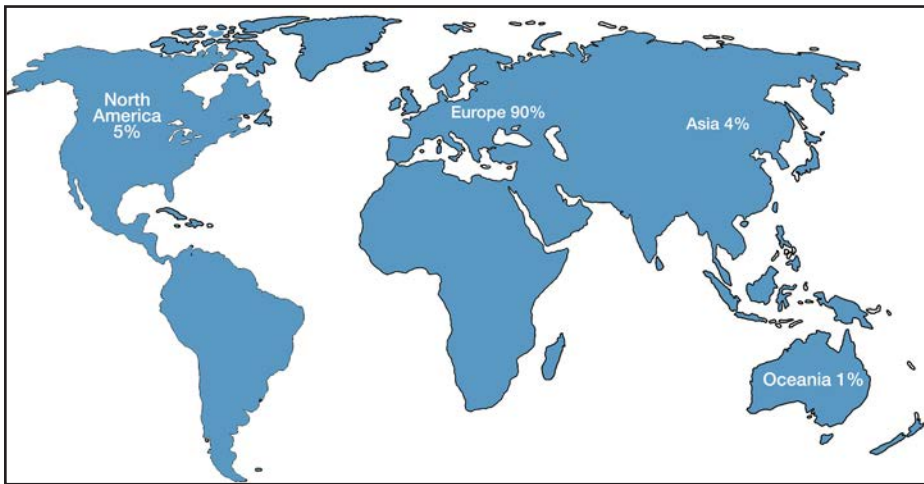

The conversation continued into the networking breaks and beyond with both private sector and public sector individuals having a say on the different perspectives of Road User Charging.

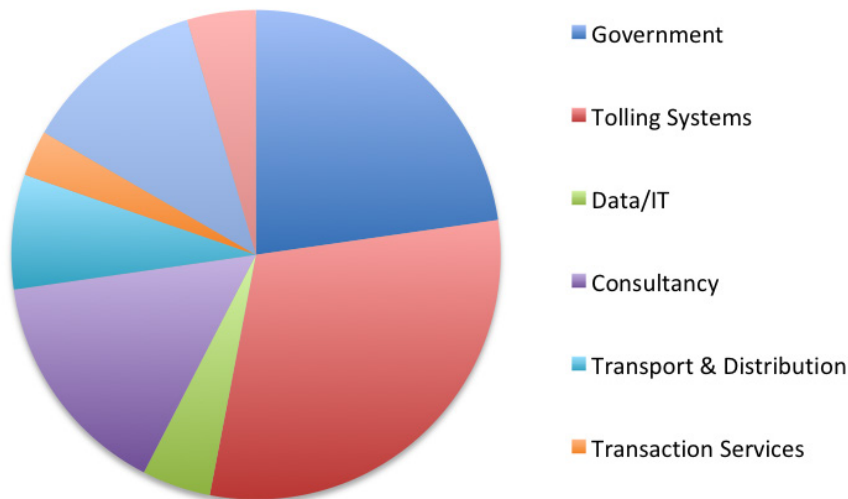

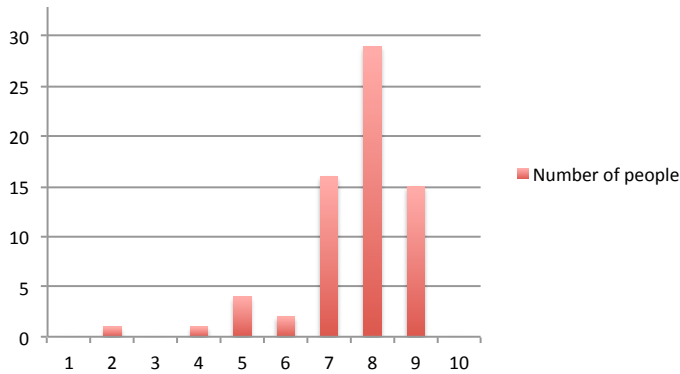

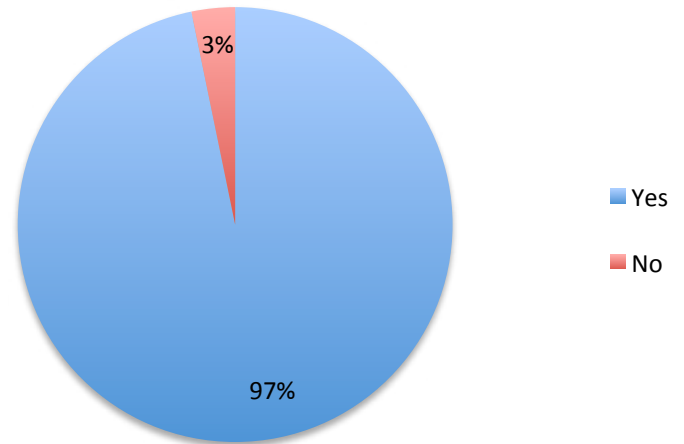
